BIO – Brendan McPhillips, who will present for Associate Membership on Monday 16 November 2020

Brendan McPhillips is a psychotherapist in private practice in Sydney. He studied medicine at the University of NSW, and, after graduating in 1980 and working in the public hospital system for 5 years, he was a general practitioner in the inner west until 1994. Since 1994 to the present he has been a therapist mostly in a group practice in Glebe and now Ultimo.

Having initially been interested in Jungian psychology, from 1994 to 1997 he did the diploma in adult psychotherapy with ANZAP. In 2000 he participated in the Supervisor's Course offered by ANZAP, and from 2004 to 2006 he completed the Master of Medicine (Psychotherapy) at Sydney University. In 2018 he began a PhD with the School of the History and Philosophy of Science at Sydney University with the topic: Transformative Process in Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy.

Anton Aronstan is a Clinical Psychologist and Child and Adolescent Psychotherapist. After his clinical psychology training in South Africa and then the UK, he completed a six year specialised training in Child and Adolescent Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy in London at the Tavistock Clinic and the British Association of Psychotherapists. Since then he has had 18 years' experience working psychotherapeutically with children, adolescents and more recently with adults, across a variety of private and public health settings in the UK, and then for the past nine years, in Australia. He currently works in private practice in Sydney as a psychotherapist and supervisor and also teaches at the Institute of Child and Adolescent Psychotherapy (ICAPP).
